





## Main menu

The main menu offers a number of useful links:

- Home takes you to the main Titles/Browse/Index/Search user-interface – or to the Log in page if you are not yet logged in.
- The Resource center links to a stock of Anatomy.tv and Primal Pictures information and publicity resources.
- The Faculty area provides downloadable teaching resources, available to users with an administrator login.
- Lastly, you'll find a link to the frequently asked questions page.

## Help menu


Choose from an range of learning materials which will teach you every aspect of Anatomy.tv and its range of titles.

## User name and Password

Note that if your institution is IP authenticated you will be taken to the products page automatically without having to log in so you will not see this page and login area.

## Other portals

Athens or Shibboleth users should click on the appropriate link and log in via the Athens or Shibboleth sites.



Once you have entered a valid user name and password, you'll be taken to the main user-interface. The **Titles** tab is selected by default, where you can view and launch the individual products in your subscription.

### Search box

The new search functionality enables you to find exactly what you are looking for before launching a product.


Our product titles are split into categories, which can be accessed using the tabs on left-hand-side.

You can now also scroll up and down in the main window to view and launch the products in your subscription.

Click on the mobile icon to see which of your titles are compatible with Android and Apple phones and tablets.

Select any title thumbnail to launch the product in a new window.

Our 3D Real-time product series comes in a range of different languages. Select the tab for the language you would like to view.




# Search box



Begin typing in the search box and you will be presented with a drop-down list of suggested results.

Type your search term in the search box, then press your return key or click on the magnifying glass icon...

The autofill feature will remember your previous searches and list possible search terms as you type - great if you're not sure of the correct spelling or want to see all the options available before making a selection.




... alternatively, you can choose one of the suggestions in the drop-down list.

Once you have submitted a search term, you will be presented with the results in the Results panel. We offer an incredible range of content on Anatomy.tv, so in order to ensure you open the most appropriate product, we have prioritized the options for you.

To open the result our recommended product, simply click on the thumbnail image.

Alternatively, if you would like to see more options, click on the result's title box.




Results are grouped in categories by media type, so you can easily navigate to the type of content you're looking for.

# Results panel – drop-down options



There's usually more than one way to see each result – use the drop-down options panel to show you where else it's available.



Clicking on the result title-box reveals the drop down panel, which contains a larger preview image, followed by up to three top recommendations:

- **View** in 3D Atlas (or similar HTML5 products)
- **Explore** in 3D Real-time
- **Learn** in Anatomy and Physiology.

You can click on any of these further options to open them in their respective products.


If the result appears in other product titles, you can explore these by clicking on the plus icon.

The filters allow you to narrow down your results by region, system, media type or product title. As you select each filter, more detailed options will become available to help you focus your results even further.

To undo your filter selections and return to the original unfiltered state, simply click the 'Reset' button.

Minimize any filter options you don't need by clicking on the gray header bar.

Filters with arrows next to them contain sub-filters that you can use to refine your results further.



The filter check-boxes take on different colors to indicate their status.

- Initial state, results are displayed.
- Results displayed, filter has been selected by user.
- Results partially displayed (some filters in sub-folder are unchecked).
- Results hidden, filter may be re-ticked in order to re-display results.
- Results hidden, filter has become unavailable.

# Results panel – other controls




Organize your workspace and add additional searches.

You can make more space to view your results by minimizing the header bar using this button.

To add another Search or Browse panel, click the '+' icon. This enables you to refer back to a search you made earlier in your session.

The Filter panel can be hidden and shown using this button.

You can minimize a category by clicking on its name in the header bar.



If there are more results than can fit on one row, you will see this button. Click on it to show, or hide those results.

For convenience, the Anatomy.tv footer is hidden by default. You can show, or hide it again using this button.


The Browse menu provides an alternative way to navigate your subscription – our team of Anatomists have categorized every last bit of our content by region and system, from slides and movies to the smallest 3D structures.

Browse allows you to take a broader look at what is available and quickly find the content that's most relevant to you.

Clicking on an arrow opens the next menu level, showing the sub-categories under that particular heading.


If you select the text of an item which has an arrow, all the content of that item plus its sub-folders will be returned in the results panel.

If a menu-item doesn't have an associated arrow, it contains no sub-categories. Selecting it will return results for that item only.



Once you have selected a Browse menu item, you are taken to the Results panel.

Browse result panels feature a 'cookie-crumble trail', showing where your chosen term fits within the anatomical hierarchy. You can click on any of the preceding 'crumbs' to display the results for that term.



# Index panel




The Index panel lists every piece of Anatomy.tv content alphabetically.

Click on any of the letter or number tabs to navigate to content starting with that letter or number.

Along with the name, each result will have a media icon next to it as well as the name of the product the result appears in, so you can easily decide which result is right for you.

Click on any result to launch the appropriate product.



The media icons represent the following types of content:

- 3D view
- Slide
- Structure
- Animation
- Movie
